Reflecting on the Word:

Reflecting on the Word In today's Gospel, Jesus approaches Thomas, inviting him to touch him and believe. At last, Thomas comes to believe that Christ is risen, and professes his faith with these beautiful words: "My Lord and my God!" As we behold the risen Lord, present in the Eucharist, we can make Thomas' prayer of faith our own: "My Lord and My God!" In the Eucharist, Jesus is alive and makes himself available to our senses so that we can touch and even taste his living presence. What a tremendous mercy!

Living the word

Jesus pours out mercy and peace on us. Have a conversation this week about these two divine gifts. What is mercy? What does it look like in our lives? Point out moments of mercy in your week. If someone makes a mistake and another person responds not in anger, but with gentle love, name that as mercy and give thanks to God for that gift. Do the same for any moments when you experience peace or share Christ's peace with one another.
