Reflecting on the Word:

Today's Gospel Reading invites reflection on the root of generosity: gratitude. God calls us to give generously to others – to cure and cleanse with the power of God's love, to drive out evil with the power of our prayer, to raise others to new life by sharing Christ with them. Such generosity is only possible if we have first received Christ into our own hearts and lives. To equip us to share Christ's love generosity with others, let us drink deeply from the gifts of love that he pours out to us in a special way at each and every Mass.

Living the Word:

In response to all that God has done for us, today's Gospel calls us to serve another with a generous heart. One of the ways that we can do this is to live the corporal works of mercy. This week, have a conversation about these works: feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick, visiting the imprisoned, burying the dead, and giving alms to the poor. Discuss how different members of the family gift one another with these works of mercy and find ways to show your gratitude to one another for these works, then, make a plan to enact one of these works for someone outside of your home.

Reflexion de la Palabra:

El evangelio de hoy nos lleva a reflexionar en la raíz de la generosidad: la gratitud. Dios nos llama a dar generosamente: a curar y limpiar con el poder del amor de Dios, a expulsar el mal con el poder de nuestra oración, a levantar a otros a una nueva vida compartiéndoles a Cristo. Tal generosidad solo es posible si primero hemos recibido a Cristo en el corazón y vida. Para compartir generosamente de los dones de amor que el derrama sobre nosotros de manera especial en cada misa.

Vivir la Palabra:

Como respuesta a lo que Dios ha hecho por nosotros, el evangelio nos llama a servirnos unos a otros con un corazón generoso. Luego, hagan un plan para representar una de estas obras para alguien fuera de su hogar.
