JULY 5, 2026 ~ FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reflecting on the Word:

Today’s Gospel seems to be a particular gift for families. First, Jesus tells us that much is hidden from those who are learned that little ones can see quite clearly. We are called to humility, trusting that those moments when we feel that we know the least can also be moments where God is revealing himself to us and to the children entrusted to us. Finally, we are reminded that we do not carry our burdens alone. While Jesus does not promise to take away our burdens, he promises to walk beside us as we carry them.

Living the Word:

This week, look for ways you can participate in Jesus’ work of coming alongside those carrying heavy burdens. This could be as simple as helping someone carry the laundry from one room to another or working together on things like dishes or cleaning up rooms. It could also be more involved-is there someone you know going through a challenging time? Could you bring them a meal or help them with yard work? Brainstorm as a family to see what you can come up with and work together to help ease someone else’s burdens.

Esta semana, ideen formas de participar en la obra de Jesús que acompaña a quienes llevan cargas pesadas. Esto podría ser tan simple como ayudar a alguien a llevar la ropa sucia de una habitación a otra, o trabajar juntos limpiando platos o habitaciones. Mas todavía, ¿conocen a alguien que este pasando por un momento difícil? ¿Podrían llevarle comida o ayudarlo a podar el césped? Hagan una lluvia de ideas en familia y trabajen juntos para ayudar a aliviar las cargas de otra persona.
